Pattern Testing What do Inced

BASIC SEWING MACHINE

You do not need a fancy, expensive sewing machine. A basic sewing machine with buttonhole foot + zipper foot is simple enough to start testing sewing patterns.

SERGER (OPTIONAL)

A serger finishes your fabric's raw edges and seam allowances with a neat, professional-looking stitch. Your sewing machine is totally capable of finishing edges with a zigzag stitch. You can sew any project without a serger, even knits.

SEWING SUPPLIES

Fabric scissors , thread & needles. Ruler, measuring tape & pins. Buttons & Zippers.

FABRICS

Different patterns require different amounts and different types of fabrics – cotton, linen, knits etc. Cotton fabric is a popular choice for sewing due to its versatility and breathability.

COMPUTER & PRINTER

Basic Computer and Printer to print the patterns. Access to Social media Tester groups, Email, Dropbox etc.

CAMERA / PHONE

A high-quality cell phone or simple DSLR camera are all you need to take incredible photos of your beautiful sews.

COFFEE

Pattern Testing How it works

PATTERN TESTER CALL / ANNOUNCEMENT

Social Media Groups Newsletters - Mailing List Open Tester Calls on the Co Website

DISTRIBUTION OF THE PATTERNS

Once testers are chosen, the designer sends out the pattern files by Email, Dropbox- Google Link or uploads the files in Closed Tester Groups on Social Media.

TESTING THE PATTERN / SEWING THE MUSLIN-TOILÉ

Read the instructions, Print out the pattern, Assemble, Grade & Cut the pattern, Cut your muslin fabric & Sew.

FEEDBACK & FIT PHOTOS

Testers provide detailed feedback on Fit Adjustments, Instruction Clarity, Spelling Errors & Pattern Accuracy. Fit Photos-should showcase the garment being wornfront & back, arms up & down, details etc.

FINALIZING THE PATTERNS / SEWING THE FINAL

Designer finalizes the pattern. Sew your final garment using desired fabric with attention to detail - finishing techniques, stitching or adding closures etc.

FINAL PHOTOS

These pictures should be clear, well-lit and show the pattern in full, with several detailed photos.
